

## VILLAGE OF CORRALES RESOLUTION NO. 09-056

### CALLING FOR A REGULAR ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 2, 2010 IN THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES THAT:

Section 1. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 2, 2010. Polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M.

Section 2. At the regular municipal election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:

One Mayor for a four year term

(District 1) ONE Councilor for a four year term.

(District 3) ONE Councilor for a four year term.

(District 4) ONE Councilor for a four year term.

Section 3. The following locations are designated as polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal election:

Voters in District 1 shall vote at the Corrales Fire Substation, 100 Paseo Tomas Montoya for Mayor and One Councilor

Voters in District 2 shall vote at the Corrales Main Fire Station, 4920 Corrales Road for Mayor

Voters in District 3 shall vote at the Historic Old Church, 966 Old Church Road for Mayor and One Councilor

Voters in District 4 shall vote at the Corrales Recreation Center, 500 Jones Road for Mayor and One Councilor

Voters in District 5 shall vote at the Corrales Fire Station, 4920 Corrales Road for Mayor

Voters in District 6 shall vote at the Corrales Recreation Center, 500 Jones Road for Mayor

Absentee voting: Office of the Village Clerk, 4324 Corrales Road

Section 4. Absentee Voting. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., February 26, 2010. After 5:00 p.m. on February 26, 2010, all

unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 2, 2010.

Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, January 26, and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010.

Early Voting. Early voting on paper ballots counted by M100 electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 10, 2010 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010.


- Section 5 Persons desiring to register to vote at the regular municipal election must register with the County Clerk of Sandoval County not later than Tuesday, February 2, 2010 at 5:00 P.M., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.
- Section 6 All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 5, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- Section 7 All Declarations of Write in Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 12, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- Section 8 The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by M100 electronic vote tabulators.
