

The Harvey Jones control channel has filled with sand and silt at the Corrales Road Bridge creating the danger of flooding if another storm events occurs. The current areas of concern are the low lying areas near the mouth of the channel where it enters the Rio Grande. Corrales emergency officials advise residence to listen to the local news and weather stations please monitor the weather in the area. Sand bags are available at the fire station at 4920 Corrales Road. Everyone should be prepared to evacuate if necessary. Prepare importation paperwork, clothing animals and medications in case of the need to evacuate. If an evacuation is called for by emergency officials the Recreation center at 500 Jones Road will be opened.
