



## **Liquid Waste Assistance Project For Indigent Households In the Middle Rio Grande Basin May 2011**

The Office of the Natural Resource Trustee (ONRT) and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) are conducting a project within the Middle Rio Grande Basin (MRGB) to eliminate illegal cesspools or other substandard household septic systems serving indigent households that threaten water quality and public health. Many of these substandard systems also pose threats of entrapment, asphyxiation and drowning, especially to children. ONRT is funding the project with \$230,000 from natural resource damage settlements for hazardous substance contamination sites in the MRGB. The funds are being used to either replace illegal cesspools or improper septic systems with a modern liquid waste system or connect the household to public sewer, if available. The project area includes Sandoval, Valencia and Socorro Counties. Bernalillo County already has an indigent assistance program in place. NMED will administer the project and will recruit and screen indigent households, issue work orders to a licensed construction contractor, and oversee and inspect the construction work.

NMED estimates that there are approximately 5,300 indigent households with on-site septic systems in Sandoval, Socorro and Valencia counties. While it is unknown how many of these 5,300 septic systems are substandard, funding should be sufficient to assist 25 to 30 households.

Applicants who are within 150% of the most recent Poverty Guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, <http://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty/10poverty.shtml>, will qualify as indigent and will be eligible for assistance. Eligible applicants will be provided with assistance on a first-come, first-serve basis and prioritized by the likelihood their current system could contaminate groundwater. Assistance will be provided until the funds are depleted.

NMED will issue work orders to a licensed construction contractor on a site-by-site basis. Funds will not be transferred to homeowners, and homeowners who have had work done on their own will not be eligible for reimbursement. Funds also will not be used to install liquid waste systems for new homes being constructed or at existing homes to accommodate increases in design flow.
