



## VILLAGE OF CORRALES

### RESOLUTION NO. 2009-006

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CHIEF'S OVERTIME PAYABLE TO VILLAGE POLICE OFFICERS EMPLOYED FOR SPECIAL EVENTS REQUIRING POLICE PRESENCE IN EXCESS OF USUAL STAFFING LEVELS; PROVIDING THAT CHIEF'S OVERTIME SHALL BE PAYABLE SOLELY FROM FUNDS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THAT ARE LEGALLY AVAILABLE FOR SUCH PAYMENTS AND NOT FROM THE VILLAGE'S GENERAL FUND; ESTABLISHING PAY RATES FOR THE PAYMENT OF CHIEF'S OVERTIME.

**WHEREAS**, certain special events in the Village of Corrales (the "Village"), such as but not limited to the Harvest Festival and the Fourth of July parade, present an occasional and recurring need for the presence of police officers in excess of usual staffing levels to provide adequate traffic control, crowd control, and other public safety purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been customary for the Village to compensate officers and civilian employees of the Police Department working overtime hours (as determined pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. § 207 and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, and the policies of the Village's Police Department) for such special events to be compensated from Police Department funds available for that purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council finds and determines that police officers and civilian employees of the Police Department working overtime hours for special events, as authorized or required by the Chief of Police, should be fairly compensated for such overtime services at reasonable pay rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES, THAT:

1. **Authorization:** The Chief of Police (the "Chief") is authorized to provide for increased police staffing levels for special events as determined to be necessary and appropriate by the Chief, and to provide that police officers and civilian employees working overtime hours to provide such staffing shall be paid for their overtime hours at the Chief's Overtime rates hereinafter set forth. Chief's Overtime for the Chief of Police must be approved by the Village Administrator.


2. **Sources of Funding:** Chief's Overtime shall be payable solely from funds of the Police Department that are legally available for such purpose, as determined by the Chief with the concurrence of the Village Administrator, and shall not be payable from the Village's general fund.

3. **Rate of Pay:** Overtime hours payable as Chief's Overtime in accordance with this Resolution shall be compensated at one and one-half times the police officer's regular pay rate, or the rate set forth in the following table, whichever is **greater**:


| <u>Position:</u>   | <u>Chief's Overtime Rate:</u> |
|--------------------|-------------------------------|
| Chief              | \$ 42.00 per hour             |
| Captain            | \$ 39.00 per hour             |
| Lieutenant         | \$ 37.00 per hour             |
| Sergeant           | \$ 35.00 per hour             |
| Officer            | \$ 32.00 per hour             |
| Civilian Personnel | \$ 28.00 per hour             |
