RESOLUTION 09-008

A Resolution to support legislation, Senate Bill 30, pending in the First Session, 2009 of the 49th Legislature of the State of New Mexico which would provide for assistance to indigent persons to replace substandard liquid waste disposal systems; create a fund; making an appropriation.

Whereas, the Village of Corrales does contain substandard liquid waste disposal systems and,

Whereas, SB 30 would establish a Liquid Waste Disposal Assistance Fund for indigent individuals or households without the financial resources to replace cesspools or connect to centralized wastewater collection systems; and


Whereas, financing is a problem faced by low-income, long-time property owners in the neighborhood commercial zone of the Village where a collector wastewater line is in the final stage of design; and

Whereas, the Village has grants from the federal EPA, Sandoval County, and capital outlays for the engineering, design and construction costs – but the connection expense for low-income families remains a barrier to public acceptance of this much needed project to protect our community's groundwater ;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales expresses its support for the S.B. 30, introduced in the First Session, 2009, of the 49th Legislature of the State of New Mexico, and directs the Mayor to communicate its support to the Senators and Representatives whose districts include the Village of Corrales.
