



VILLAGE OF CORRALES RESOLUTION 09-014

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CORRALES COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL EVENT KNOWN AS CROSSWALK AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales has enacted ordinances which govern the use of public roads and trails by vehicular, pedestrian, bicycle and equestrian traffic and enforces these laws to ensure the public's safety while using public roads and trail ways for personal transportation and recreation, and requires the public to be knowledgeable of the law and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales Governing Body has appointed citizen committees to advise it on how vehicular, pedestrian, bicycle and equestrian travel can be best managed to ensure the safe use of public roads and trail ways by citizens in the village for personal transportation and recreation and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Village has been advised by appointed citizen committees that greater awareness by the public concerning the laws governing the use of crossings in the Village will increase the communities enjoyable and safe use of public road and trail ways for personal transportation and recreation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES THAT:

Crosswalk Awareness Day is an event to raise public awareness and knowledge of the laws governing the use of crossing on public roads and the responsibilities of vehicular, pedestrian, bicycle and equestrian users.

Crosswalk Awareness Day will be held in the Village of Corrales, Sunday April 26, 2009 from 10am to 1pm.
