**RESOLUTION NO. 10-008**

**A RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE SPEED LIMIT ON  
APPLEWOOD ROAD**

**Whereas**, the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales has the authority to establish traffic regulations and controls within the Village; and

**Whereas**, Section 34-42 of the Code of Ordinances states that no person shall drive a vehicle on any street at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on paved streets not otherwise posted with a lower speed limit; and

**Whereas**, Applewood Road, a public residential road, is a paved road currently posted at fifteen (15) miles per hour, though good visibility exists at intersections and driveways in large part; and

**Whereas**, on February 23, 2010, residents of Applewood Road petitioned the Governing Body for an increase of the speed limit to twenty-five (25) miles per hour,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

1. The speed limit on Applewood Road shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
2. The Village Administration is instructed to implement the foregoing provision as promptly as is reasonable feasible by posting the appropriate sign.
