RESOLUTION NO. 10-060

A RESOLUTION TO PERMIT THE HIRING OF A CORRALES POLICE OFFICER

WHEREAS, the recent untimely death of the detective sergeant in the Village of Corrales Police Department has created the need for a replacement to perform essential investigative and administrative tasks; and

WHEREAS, the position of detective sergeant may be filled by promotion of a member of the existing force, thus creating a vacancy in the current staffing of officers maintained to assure the public's safety; and


WHEREAS, the position to be filled pursuant to this Resolution was funded in the Fiscal Year 2010-11 budget approved by the Governing Body pursuant to Resolution No. 10-034, adopted July 20, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 10-046, adopted October 12, 2010, mandated a hiring freeze for full- and part-time positions for the duration of this fiscal year 2010-11:


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES, THAT:

1. The Chief of Police is authorized to advertise for, and upon approval of the Governing Body, to hire an officer to be assigned as a Corrales Police Department employee.
2. This authority is granted notwithstanding Resolution 10-046, adopted October 12, 2010.
