RESOLUTION NO. 10-017

**A RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE SPEED LIMIT ON
APPLEWOOD ROAD**

Whereas, the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales has the authority to establish traffic regulations and controls within the Village; and

Whereas, Section 34-42 of the Code of Ordinances states that no person shall drive a vehicle on any street at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on paved streets not otherwise posted with a lower speed limit; and

Whereas, Applewood Road, a public residential road, is a paved road currently posted at fifteen (15) miles per hour, though good visibility exists at intersections and driveways in large part; and

Whereas, on February 23, 2010, residents of Applewood Road petitioned the Governing Body for an increase of the speed limit; and

Whereas, Applewood Road is designated as a "CHAMP" (equestrian) trail route in the Corrales Trails Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

1. The speed limit on Applewood Road shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.
2. The Village Administration is instructed to implement the foregoing provision as promptly as is reasonable feasible by posting the appropriate signage.
