RESOLUTION 11-002

**A resolution in support of the
Central New Mexico Community College Bond Election**

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Corrales Village Council to support the higher education needs and quality of life of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Central New Mexico Community College will hold an election on Feb. 1, 2011, and the ballot will ask voters in the CNM District, which includes Corrales, to decide on whether to support a \$70 million bond issue for CNM; and

WHEREAS, approval of the bond issue will not increase property tax rates; and

WHEREAS, approval of the bond will provide funding for capital and renovation projects that would improve learning environments for students, position CNM to reduce energy costs and provide much-needed renovations to some of CNM's oldest buildings; and

WHEREAS, the projects will significantly enhance CNM's ability to serve the educational needs of citizens in Corrales and the projects will result in more optimal learning environments for the largest higher education student body in the state; and


WHEREAS, the quality of higher education in a community is directly linked to the quality of life for all residents; and

WHEREAS, continued support of CNM's role of providing high quality higher education at an affordable cost is vital to the development of a skilled workforce and economic growth in the region;


