



VILLAGE OF CORRALES STATE OF NEW MEXICO

RESOLUTION 11-004

A resolution declaring the eligibility and intent of the Safe Routes to School Team, a committee lawfully appointed by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, to sponsor an award from the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Safe Routes to School non-infrastructure funds.

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales has lawfully appointed a Safe Routes to School Team; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, accepts a \$25,000 Phase 2 non-infrastructure award from the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) funds set forth by the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU); and

WHEREAS, the school-based walking and cycling activities named in the SRTS Phase 2 application are eligible activities under the NM SRTS program and SAFETEA-LU and are included in the Village of Corrales, New Mexico's SRTS Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Public Schools District is a co-sponsor of this project application; and

WHEREAS, after appropriate public input and due consideration, the Villager of Corrales accepts this funding award from the NMDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE Village of Corrales, NEW MEXICO, that

SECTION 1. The Village of Corrales, New Mexico, does hereby authorize John Avila, Village Administrator to accept SRTS Phase 2 non-infrastructure funds in the amount of \$25,000 from the NMDOT for SRTS activities and projects on behalf of the citizens of Village of Corrales, New Mexico.

SECTION 2. That the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, hereby assures the NMDOT that sufficient funding for the school-based walking and cycling activities is available, as the SRTS Program is a reimbursement program.

SECTION 3. That the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, hereby assures the NMDOT that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of any equipment purchased using the SRTS Phase 2 non-infrastructure funds will be available for the life of the equipment.
