**A RESOLUTION SPONSORING THE 17th ANNUAL FOURTH
OF JULY PARADE AND FAMILY FUN DAY.**

WHEREAS, for the past sixteen years, Corrales has had a parade on the Fourth of July, organized by local residents; and

WHEREAS, the sponsors for the event will be Corrales MainStreet, Inc. and the Village of Corrales; and

WHEREAS, the parade will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Monday July 4th, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the 4th of July committee has attended an administrative review meeting, as scheduled by the Village Clerk, with a completed Event Permit application, site plan, and summary; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the parade, Corrales MainStreet, Inc. will sponsor a "Family Fun Day", encouraging families to enjoy live music and refreshments following the parade at La Entrada Park; and

WHEREAS, the sponsors recognize that the Parade and Fun Day involve direct and indirect costs to municipal operations, among them Police Department overtime and waiver of rental fees for La Entrada Park.

WHEREAS, Corrales' name derived from the great number of corrals in our community; and

WHEREAS, Corrales has been named the Horse Capital of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, horses have always been a part of the Corrales 4th of July Parade.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Corrales joins Corrales MainStreet, Inc. in sponsoring the 17th Annual Fourth of July Parade.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that horses be invited to participate in this years' 4th of July Parade.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby gives its approval to close a portion of Corrales Road NM 448 on July 4, 2011 from 9:30 AM. to 12:00 PM and instructs the Mayor to so inform the New Mexico Department of Transportation.
