ROAD FUND (LGRF) HARDSHIP MATCH WAIVER PROGRAM

TRANSPORTATION**

Whereas, the Village of Corrales has accepted participation in the 2011/2012 Local Government Road CO-OP program project number SP-3-12(908); and

Whereas, the total cost of the project selected for program is \$125,000; and

Whereas, the Village of Corrales is tasked with a matching contribution to the program of \$41,667; and

Whereas, the Village allocated the Gas tax revenue to meet the local contribution required; and


Whereas, there has been no gas sold or taxed in the Village for over a year; and

Whereas, the matching funds would be required from an already devastated GRT funding causing undue hardship to Local public service operations.

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Village of Corrales, New Mexico Governing Body that the Village request s a match waiver in the amount of \$41,667 for LGRF project SP-3-12(908) for the year 2011-2012 to rehabilitate and improve local roads in the Village of Corrales, Sandoval County, New Mexico

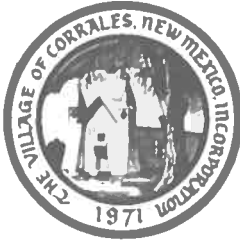
