



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

RESOLUTION NO. 11-053

A RESOLUTION REDISTRICTING COUNCILOR DISTRICTS IN THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES FOR THE NEXT MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of New Mexico a municipality with fewer than ten thousand (10,000) residents may, but is not required to, adopt a districting plan for the election of members of the governing body, one member being selected from each district; and

WHEREAS, redistricting is required for municipalities following the decennial U.S. Census counts; and

WHEREAS, the consultants selected by the Village have recommended to the Village, in accordance with established legal principles for proportional representation, a change in boundaries to Districts 1, 4, and 6; and

WHEREAS, the district boundaries must be defined and addresses verified and submitted to the Sandoval County Bureau of Elections before December 13, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council, the governing body of the Village, that:

1. The Village shall increase the population of District 4 and 6.
2. The Village shall decrease the population of District 1.
3. The configuration of the district boundaries shall be as shown on Plan 1, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
4. The Village Clerk shall supply address information consistent with the districts shown on Plan 1 to the Sandoval County Bureau of Elections
5. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Village, and shall be in effect for the regular municipal election that is to take place in March 6, 2012, and continuing thereafter.

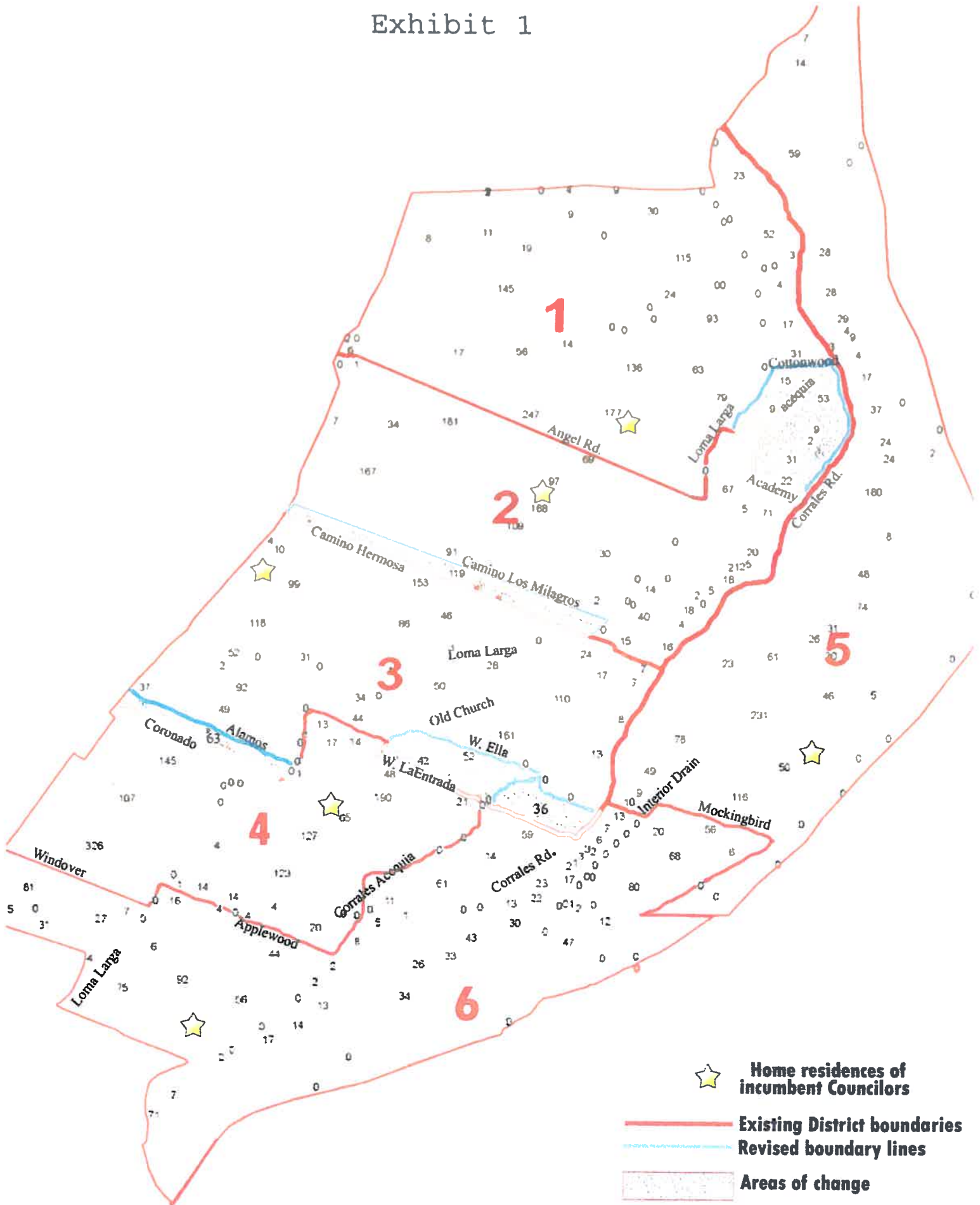
