CALLING FOR A REGULAR ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 6, 2012 IN THE VILLAGE OF
CORRALES:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:

- Section 1. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 6, 2012. Polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M.
- Section 2. At the regular election, persons will be elected to fill the following elective offices:

| At Large | One Municipal Judge | 4 year term |
- Section 3. In accordance with NMSA 1978 §3-8-10, the following districts are consolidated for the regular municipal election:
- CD01: Consists of districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6
- Section 4. The following locations are designated as the polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal election.
- Voting Convenience Center: Corrales Recreation Center, 500 Jones Road (all districts)
- Absentee and Early Voting: Office of the Village Clerk, 4324 Corrales Road
- Section 5. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 10, 2012 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- Section 6. All Declarations of Write in Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 17, 2010 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- Section 7. Persons desiring to vote in this election must register with the Sandoval County Clerk not later than 5:00 PM on February 7, 2012, the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.
- Section 8. Absentee Voting. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., March 2, 2012. After 5:00 p.m. on March 2, 2012, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 6, 2012.


Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 15, and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2012.

Early Voting. Early voting on paper ballots counted by M100 electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 15, 2012 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2012.

Section 9. The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by M100 electronic vote tabulators.




